

The legal Frame

BauKarussell

The Recycled Construction Materials ordinance adresses the building owners.

- §4. (3) "Within the **pollutant and impurities survey** …also elements/materials should be listed, that can be handed over for a prearation for reuse."
- § 5. (1) "... Those elements that can be handed over for a **prearation** for reuse and that are addressed by potential purchasers have to be removed in a way that a following preparation for reuse is not impeded...."
- And a linked standard ON B 3151 (Dismantling plan)




