List 5: Checklist for sustainable flying

- Ask yourself if the flight is really necessary. Are there more climate-friendly alternatives?
- Check airlines for their CO2 emissions (e.g. with the Airline Index of Atmosfair: https://www.atmosfair.de/) Some Airlines even rely on biofuels for certain routes!
- Choose a direct flight, since most emissions are generated during take-off and landing. And you have to fly a greater distance when you opt for connecting flights
- Take part in on-board recycling

O Consider booking through flight comparison sites with Gold Standard carbon offsetting. They offer the best price for airline tickets and offset your carbon

emissions with their revenues
